

# Science- Animals Including Humans.

Animals are living things.

There are animals living all around us.

Some animals cannot be found in the UK but can be found in other countries.

Animals eat different things.

Some animals only eat meat. These are called **carnivores**.



Some animals eat meat and plants. These are called **omnivores**.



Some animals only eat plants. These are called **herbivores**.



Animals can have very different bodies to each other.

Different body parts help animals do different things. For example, wings allow birds to fly.

**Animal-** A living thing that can move and eat and react to the world through its senses e.g. bird, insect, reptile and mammal.

**The UK-** An island country made up of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Island.

**The world-** Our planet Earth with all the people and living things upon it.

**Body-**The bones, skin and organs of an animal.

**Legs-** The part of some animals bodies that they stand on.

**Wings-** A body part that lets some animals fly.

**Feathers-** A soft, light covering on a birds body.

**Beak-** A mouthpart of some animals.

**Fins-** A thin flat part that sticks out from the body of a fish.

**Gills-**The body part that helps some animals to breathe underwater.

**Fur-**Thick hair that grows on the bodies of some animals.
