


Science-Plants




Plants reproduce in a number of different ways.

Plant reproduction is the process through which plants produce new off-spring.







Plants are living things that need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy!



Vocabulary

Plants — A living thing that grows in the earth and has a stem, leaves and roots.

Blossom – flowers on a tree or a bush.

Petal – coloured part of the flower that attracts birds and insects.

Roots — the part of the plant which holds it in place and takes in water from the ground.

Trunk — the central part of the tree that the branches grow out of.

Survive — to stay alive.

Bulbs – gives food to the plant; it is underground and the plant grows from it.

Stem - A link between the roots and the other parts of a plant such as leaves, fruits and flowers.

Temperature — Temperature is the amount of heat in something.
