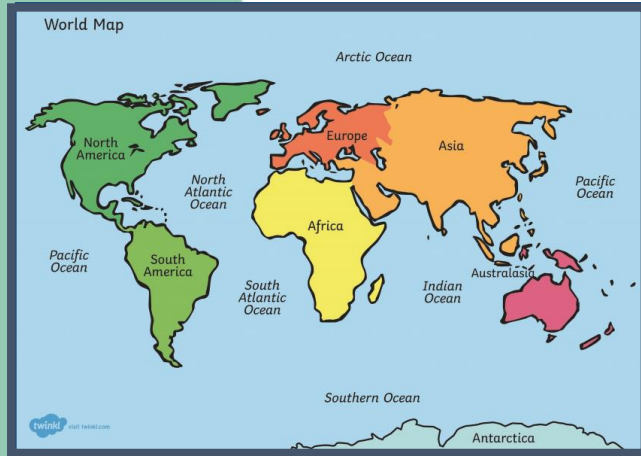
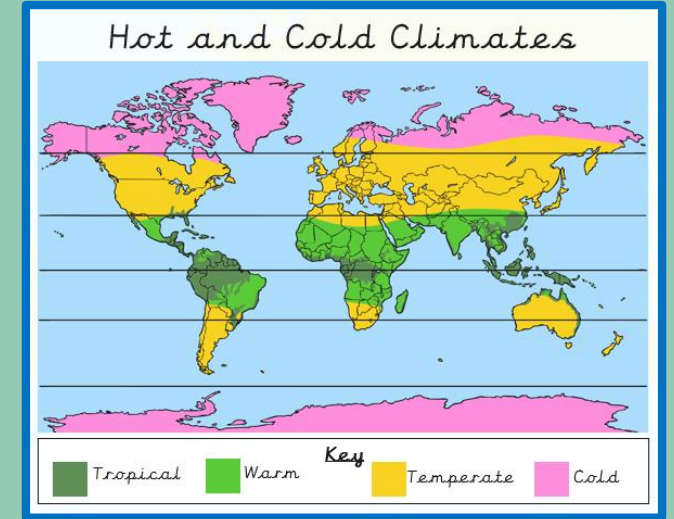


Geography - Nigeria
