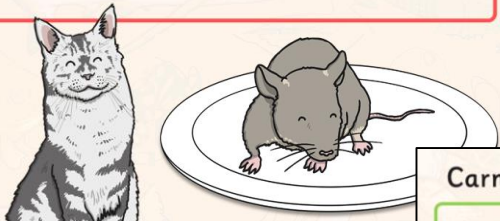

Carnivores

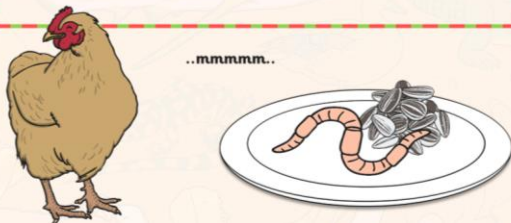
Are animals that only eat meat.

For example, a chicken can eat both worms and seeds.



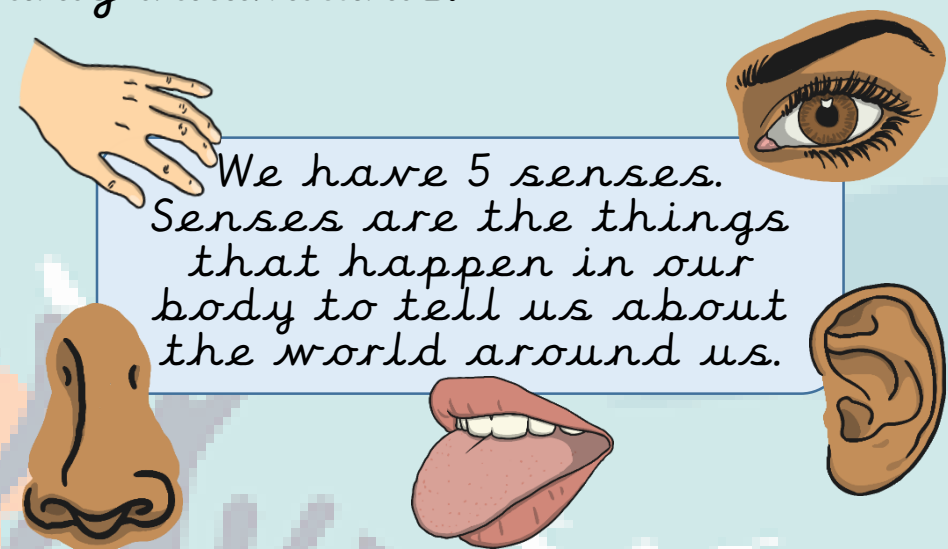
Carnivores, Herbivores, Omnivores

These can be flowers, fruit, nuts, grass or even wood.



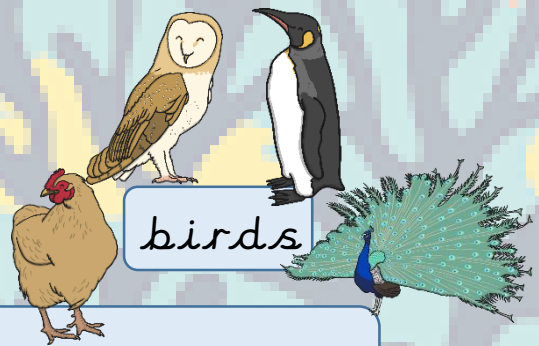
We have 5 senses.

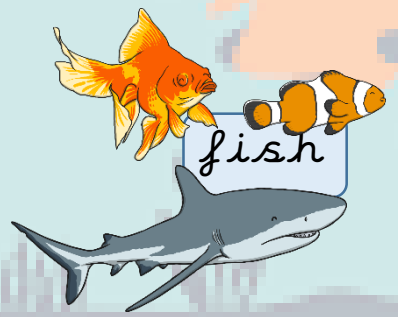


There are lots of different kinds of animals.

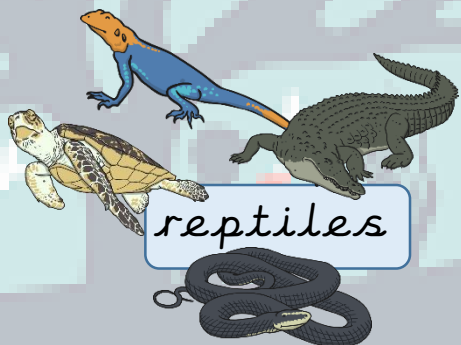

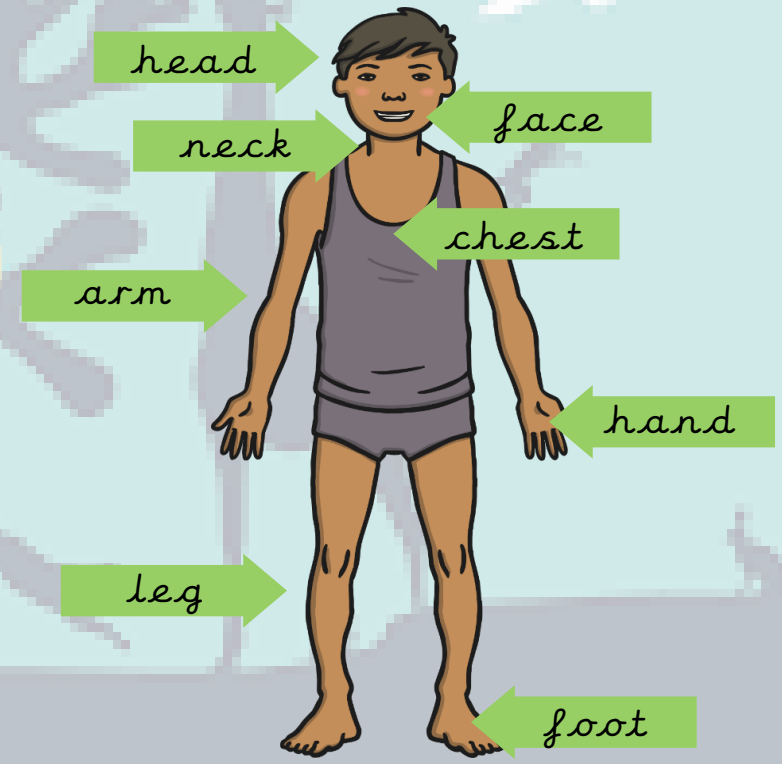

Vocabulary

Carnivore - an animal that only eats meat.

Omnivore - an animal that eats both meat and plants.

Herbivore - an animal that only eats plants.

Amphibian - live in land and water. They have moist skin and webbed feet and lay eggs.

Mammal - live on land and in water. They give birth to live young and they drink their mothers milk.

Reptile - live in land and water. They have scales, ear holes and dry skin. They lay eggs.

Bird - live on land and in water. Have feathers, a beak and wings.

Fish - live in water. They have fins to swim and gills to breath.

Smell - is one of our senses, you smell with your nose.

Taste - is one of your senses, you taste with your tongue.

Touch - is one of your senses, you touch with your hand.

Hear - is one of your senses, you hear with your ears.

Sight - is one of your senses, you see with your eyes.
