Please remember: No fizzy drinks, crisps, chocolate, nuts or energy drinks try to make healthier choices.

### **Please remember, you should not send your child to school if they are...**

1. Unwell for any reason or have a high temperature;
2. Living with a member of their household who has symptoms of coronavirus;
3. Extremely clinically vulnerable and have been advised to shield;
4. Clinically vulnerable and considered to be a higher risk of severe illness from coronavirus (parents/carers should follow medical advice before attending school);
5. Living with someone in their household who is extremely clinically vulnerable and shielding – they should only attend if the child is able to understand and follow stringent social distancing instructions.

### **Data Collection Forms**

Please can we remind everyone it is important for school to receive up to date contact information i.e. telephone numbers, emails to be able to contact you in case of emergencies. We need to have at least 2 contact names for each child. During the present situation, we urgently need you to answer the added information on whether you have access to a home computer/laptop to provide work at home for children and if not we will make sure paper copies are provided instead, please let the school know asap.
