Covid – 19

This week we have had a confirmed case of Covid -19 in school. Unfortunately this has forced the closure of two classes in Key Stage 1.

I want to reassure all parents and carers that we have a robust risk assessment in place and no staff member can come to school if they have symptoms. Staff are asked to stay at home and take a test as soon as they report symptoms. If a test is positive this is immediately reported to Public Health England and the Local Authority who provide the school with letters to send to the affected classes and to the whole school community. The identity of anyone who tests positive is confidential and this will never be disclosed.

So far we have had very few cases and have been able to keep most of our classes open. All staff, parents and carers are vital in helping us to do this. Please remember to keep your child at home if they have any of the symptoms associated with Covid-19 and let us know straight away if you or your child has a positive test result.
