

If you think you may be eligible for Free School Meals due to your current family circumstances here is how to check.

You MAY be eligible if the parent/carer receives one of the following:

- Income Support
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance or Employment and Support Allowance
- An Income-related employment and support allowance
- Support under Part V1 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, but not receiving Working Tax Credit and your annual income does not exceed £16,190
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Parents receiving Working Tax Credit for 4 weeks after their employment finishes are entitled to free school meals during that period. This also applies to parents who start working less than 16 hours per week.

If you think you may be eligible please contact the School Food Service by telephoning **2735705** or **2736401**. You will need:

- Your National Insurance Number (or NASS number)
- Names of your child/children
- Their dates of birth
